All Together Services for summer continue this Sunday, June 25.

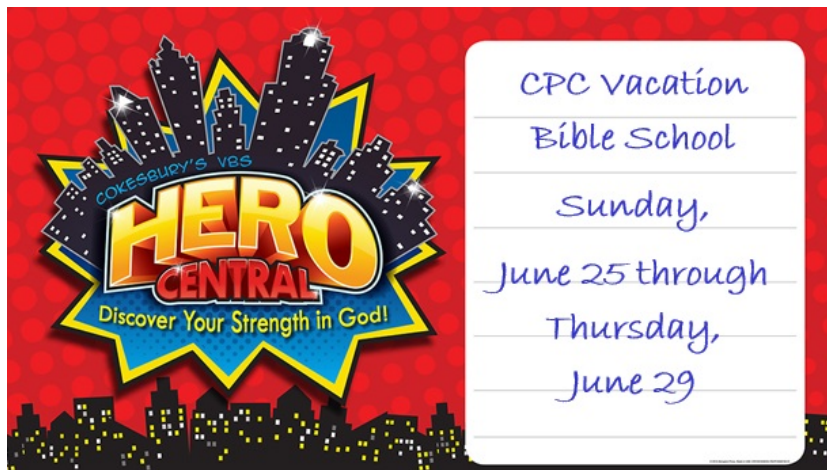

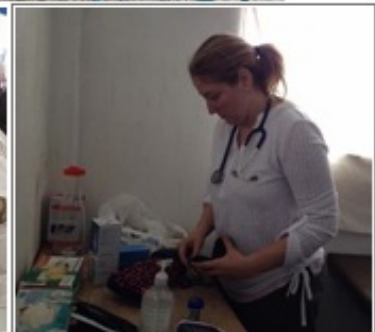


Guatemala Mission News for Fall
