Adult Sunday School Classes Try one of these!

Kerygma: On Jan. 20, *Beginnings* will start, a 4-week study covering the significant first chapters of Genesis. Led by John Page; Room 102. 'It Was VERY Good' is the first session, with an overview of the course emphasizing God's relationship to creation. Also with discussion of the relationships between the biblical description of creation, science, and history.

Bible and Beyond: Jan. 6 - Feb. 17. Study of book of Ruth using the *Uppity Women of the Bible* video series developed by Dr. Lisa M. Wolfe. Library.

Faith Today: *Short Stories by Jesus: The Enigmatic Parables of a Controversial Rabbi* by Amy Jill Levine, professor of NT studies at Vanderbilt, led by Sheri Mitten, Room 100.

Faith and Families: Currently studying *Animate: Faith*, in the Fellowship Hall.


